We are pleased to announce that we are accepting RSVPs for prospective intern tours of the Project SEARCH program at Children's Wisconsin!

Project SEARCH is a nine-month internship program for individuals with disabilities. It is targeted for individuals whose goal is competitive employment. The program will take place at Children's Wisconsin, a setting where total immersion in the workplace facilitates the teaching and learning process as well as the acquisition of employability and marketable work skills. Interns participate in three internships to explore a variety of career paths. The interns work with a team that includes their family, an instructor, and local and state agencies to create an employment goal.

Tours include a walkthrough of a select few internship sites, an explanation of the program details, along with the opportunity to meet the interns. Tours will take approximately 1.5 hours.
